Shibori Silk Dyeing Workshop

With Yanny Split

Skill level: From beginners onwards – all you need is a love of fabric art

From bringing colour to the silk, to manipulating and shaping, to overdyeing - all the techniques of Shibori. You will make a lot of different samples and learn three exciting techniques that will give you ideas for endless designs: Arashi pole wrapping; folding – cloth is pleated and bound; stitching and gathering. You will have three great colourful days and will get inspired to make individual pieces out of the silk, or work those pieces in with fibre art. Combine with quilting, embroidery, weaving, knitting, crochet, 3D fibre art and or wearable art. Your life will never be the same again.

Tutor will provide a kit containing: 20 different colours of Selfix dyes and discharge medium.

Students are to bring:

- 3 metres of silk (pure silk paj 6.5m/m boiled off finish or pure silk habotai 8m/m boiled off finish. Does not have to be in one 3 metre piece as it will be cut into sample pieces.)
- 1.5 metres black 100% cotton calico
- Pencil, pen, notebook, ruler and if you have a “disappearing pen” (marker pen that is erasable by water)
- Plastic tray (or old baking tray) approximately 40cm by 30cm and height 7cm or more
- Brushes, stiff bristled: one flat about 3.5cm wide and about four or five from 1cm to 3cm wide
- Water spray bottle
- Eyedropper
- Plastic bucket 10 litre size
- Hair dryer
- 3 or more lengths of pvc pipe about 50cm long and from 5cm to 10cm in diameter (if no pipe empty wine bottles will do)
- Cotton and string, not too thick but strong
- Masking tape
- 7 empty glass (jam) jars
- Tools for clamping
- Washers
- Plastic clothes pegs
- Small G clamps
- 15 paper clips
- 8 bulldog clips
- Rubber bands
- Plastic shapes in pairs (You can make your own shapes by cutting them out of tops of plastic ice cream containers)
- Hand or machine sewing thread and needles
- Scissors
- Apron or old t-shirt to protect your clothes
- Several pairs of tight plastic gloves
- Baking paper
- Couple of old newspapers
- Some A4 paper
- Kit fee: \$35 in cash in an envelope with your name and class name on the front. Pay direct to tutor at the start of the class.
