Transfer Printing

with Dijanne Cevaal

Skill level: All

This is both a project and technique class where you will work with transfer dyes (used for colouring synthetic materials) and with developing a small series of work.

Transfer printing is a method of getting permanent colour onto synthetic materials such as Lutradur (a polyester non-woven fibre), polyester and polyester organza. Also explore methods of melting back and free hand stitching to embellish your printed fabric. Using polyester fabrics such as organza allows you to build layers and play with transparency and overlays and still create your own distinctive fabrics and pieces.

Tutor will provide the following materials for use in class:

- transfer paints in solution and polyester film/fleece

Students are to bring:

- Your normal sewing supplies including good sharp scissors
- Hand embroidery threads and needles. Bring a number of different coloured threads
- 10-20 sheets photocopy paper (not photo paper but ordinary printing paper)
- 2 paint brushes - one fine and one broader
- 4 or 5 plastic cups or small containers/jars for the paint
- A normal drawing pencil
- 50cm of polyester organza
- Some fat quarters in your favourite colours (3-4 will be fine - but think co-ordinating as well)
- Wadding (enough for 1-2 squares approximately 25cm x 25cm in size)
- Apron or coverall to protect clothing

Kit fee: \$15 in cash in an envelope with your name and class name on the front. Pay direct to tutor at the start of the class.

Suggested for your comfort:

- Cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- Bring a non-spill water bottle.
- Label your possessions with your name.
