Miniature Kimonos – from Dynasty to Digitising!

with The Australian College of Computer Embroidery and Textile Technologies, Presented by Vicky McKeown

Skill level: Intermediate – a knowledge of icons, digitising program navigation and tools is essential. This is NOT a software specific class but the student is required to be comfortable with their computer and program usage.*

Learn how to create patchwork in the embroidery hoop, in this techniques class.

How to have perfect points and ensure every block is the same size ready for construction!

Patchwork is steeped in tradition, but lifestyle dictates how much time we have.

Creating patchwork blocks though digitising provides us not only with the ability to replicate an age old craft, but to enjoy it in a time scale that is rewarding and stimulating.

You will need to bring your own working laptop with software loaded and your own embroidery machine for this class.

Note: *this is not a machine skills workshop*

Tutor will provide a kit containing:

All required threads, fabric and backings required to complete the project, at no charge to students.

Students are to bring:

- Working laptop with software loaded: Husqvarna Viking/Pfaff 4D, or Brother PE-DESIGNER 8, or Generations version 1.5 or higher, and any relevant dongles
- Embroidery machine with all cables/cards, etc, needed for communication with their own laptop
- Prior knowledge of embroidery machine and its functions
- All accessories needed for machine embroidery including hoop: hoop size 140mm x 140mm or similar (no smaller)
- Size 11/75 embroidery needles suitable for your machine brand
- Spare bobbins and bobbin thread
- Thread snips
- Note pad, pen and ruler
- Small embroidery scissors

**To successfully participate in this workshop is it very important that you are comfortable with your chosen digitising software (including icons and tasks the tools perform), your computer and your embroidery machine.*

Without supervision, you will require the skills to MANUALLY digitise a line to a specific size and shape, a satin stitched line with specific properties, various shapes with applied properties.
