## **Entwined**

With Kirry Toose

**Skill level:** Beginner/Intermediate. Basic machine knowledge required.

Project based workshop, creating a beautiful Lily Neckpiece. Develop skills in colour, design and texture through the machine manipulation of fabrics and assorted products. These concepts can also be interpreted and developed further into other design elements by the student at home.

Play with memory wire, traditional rouleaux, Angelina fibres and metallic threads. Explore free machining, creating tonal effects with threads and layering of fibres, test the reactions of certain fibres to heat and the advantage of persisting with 'that' perfect finish!

This unique piece of wearable art has an elegance and sophistication that will cause many compliments and admiring glances. Note: Pictured is the bracelet version of Lily, but in the class you will be working on the neckpiece.

**Tutor will provide** a folder containing:

Pre-cut, interlined silk fabric.

Assorted colourways of Angelina fibres

Organza and bridal tulle

Memory wire, jewellery bell-cap

Comprehensive notes and patterns

### **Students are to bring:**

- Embroidery hoop - plastic "spring clip" style or a narrow wooden hoop, screw adjustment type, approx 20cm in diameter
- Pins, needles, small embroidery scissors
- Note: please wear either glasses or safety glasses
- 2B pencil, notebook

Threads:

- Machine embroidery 2-3 shades cream, white, gold metallic plus 2-3 shades green
- Polyester (normal) mid-green tone
- Kit fee: \$15 in cash in an envelope with your name and class name on the front. Pay direct to tutor at the start of the class

Note: Sewing machines and accessories will be provided by our sponsoring machine companies.

However if you wish to bring your own it must be cleaned and oiled and you will also need to bring all equipment, accessories and spare bobbins. Free machining/open toe foot is essential.

If you are unfamiliar with these items, ask at your local sewing centre.

### **Suggested for your comfort:**

- Cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- Bring a non-spill water bottle.
- Label your possessions with your name.
