## **Broome Beanie Needle Knitting**

With Jude Skeers

**Skill level:** From beginners up

The versatile Broome Beanie is easy to knit and can be worn in a variety of ways. Learn how to knit a number of garments using a Broome Beanie Needle which is a custom made 60cm circular needle with a 10mm pin and a 6mm pin.

In this class you will learn about making the following versions:

- Broome Beanie (tubular scarf) and how to wear it
- Hooded cape (knitted from the top down)
- V- Point Poncho (knitted from the top down)
- Hooded poncho (knitted from the top down)

Also learn loose cast off techniques.

Students will choose one of the garments to knit as part of the workshop.

**Tutor will provide a kit containing:** One Broome Beanie Needle (a 60cm circular needle with a 10mm pin and a 6mm pin at either end).

Patterns: Broome Beanie, Hooded Cape, Poncho, Hooded Poncho.

### **Students are to bring:**

- Yarn: 240 metres of eyelash yarn or Faux Fur yarn such as Jazz, Ostrich, Boa or any eyelash or Faux Fur yarn
- One ball of Feathers or a Feathers copy or any other feature or novelty yarn to include in the bands
- A tapestry needle for sewing in yarn
- If you have a set of interchangeable knitting needles, they would be beneficial
- \$20 for the kit supplied by the tutor, in cash in an envelope with your name and class name on the front. Pay direct to tutor at the start of the class.
